## Step Up to Net Zero programme – Update noted.

1 With reference to minutes of the City Administration Committee of

- (1) 24th February 2022 (Print 7, page 501), approving funding for the Step up to Net Zero programme (STNZ); and
- (2) 14th September 2023 (Print 4, page 43) approving Phase II of the STNZ,

there was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Regional Economic Growth, advising that

- at the conclusion of the first phase of STNZ programme an independent evaluation had been commissioned by the Chamber of Commerce and the overall conclusions had been overwhelmingly positive as detailed in the report;
