

Glasgow's Local Housing Strategy 2023-28 – Annual review noted.

2 With reference to the minutes of the City Administration Committee of 18th May 2023 (Print 2, page 29) approving Glasgow's Local Housing Strategy (LHS) 2023-28, there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability, regarding an annual review of the progress of the actions outlined in the delivery plan of Glasgow's LHS 2023-28, advising

- (1) that under the Housing (Scotland) Act 2021, local authorities were required to prepare a LHS supported by an assessment of housing need and demand;
- (2) that the LHS outlined what the Council and its partners aimed to deliver for the city during the scheduled 5-year period and Glasgow's LHS had been prepared in accordance with Scottish Government guidance;
- (3) of the 4 grand challenges which had been identified in the Council's Strategic Plan 2022-27 for the Council to deliver against;
- (4) of the 5 strategic priorities which had been set out in Glasgow's LHS;
- (5) of the progress of Glasgow's LHS delivery plan which set out 59 actions under the 5 strategic priorities and of these actions 54 had been identified as having key milestones for delivery in year 1 (2023/24) and all these actions had been appraised using a Red, Amber and Green assessment;
- (6) that 17 actions had been assessed as Amber, involving minor slippage in targets and/or timescales and in all instances work was underway, however had not been concluded in year 1 but was anticipated to be completed during 2024/25; and
- (7) of the delivery of the LHS for 2024/25 and beyond.

After consideration, the committee noted the progress of actions and key issues arising as set out in Glasgow's Local Housing Strategy 2023-28 annual review report year one.
