

Supplementary Guidance and Planning Guidance to accompany City Development Plan 2017 etc noted.

6 There was submitted a report by Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the work being carried out on the draft planning guidance to accompany the City Development Plan (CDP) 2017, advising

- (1) that the CDP had been adopted in March 2017 and a series of Supplementary Planning Guidance accompany the CDP in order to support the implementation of the CDP;
- (2) that in order to finalise guidance associated with the CDP 2017, before focusing the work programme fully on the forthcoming CDP2, topic based guidance had been drafted on the draft Supplementary Guidance (SG) 6 Green Belt and Green Network, draft SG12 Delivering Development and draft Non-Statutory Planning Guidance on Large Scale Co-Living, as detailed in Appendices to the report;
- (3) that consultation on the SG6 Green Belt and Green Network, SG12 Delivering Development and Non-Statutory Planning Guidance on Large Scale Co-Living would be undertaken as soon as was practicable and would be conducted through the Council's consultation hub with an 8-week period of consultation; and
- (4) of the process for the adoption of the SG and Planning Guidance.

After consideration, the committee noted

- (a) the draft Supplementary Guidance 6 Green Belt and Green Network, Supplementary Guidance 12 Delivering Development and Non-Statutory Planning Guidance on Large Scale Co-Living and the intention now for consultation; and
- (b) that following the consultation exercise and any appropriate changes to the documents, a report on the outcomes would be submitted to this committee for consideration and thereafter to the City Administration Committee for approval and following approval, the draft Supplementary Guidance 6 Green Belt and Green Network and SG12 Delivering Development and statement of publicity would be sent to Scottish Ministers with a view to adoption.
