

Glasgow's Strategic Housing Investment Plan 2025/26 to 2029/30 approved.

3 Councillor Kelly, City Convener for Housing, Development, Built Heritage and Land Use, presented a report regarding Glasgow's Strategic Housing Investment Plan (SHIP) 2025/26 to 2029/30, advising

- (1) that the Scottish Government's Strategic Housing Investment Framework guided the allocation of the Affordable Housing Supply Programme to local authorities in Scotland and as part of this framework, local authorities were required to submit a SHIP annually to the Scottish Government;
- (2) that the Scottish Government long-term strategy, "Housing to 2040" had been published in March 2023 and set out the national housing priorities including a target for delivering 110,000 affordable homes by 2032;
- (3) that the SHIP 2025/26 to 2029/30 had been prepared in the context of the Council's declaration of its own housing emergency in November 2023, thus the SHIP was critical in responding to pressures associated with the housing emergency;
- (4) that the SHIP 2025/26 to 2029/30 had considered the impact of the reduced Affordable Supply Programme 2024/25 budget in relation to programme delivery and funding allocations going forward;
- (5) that the SHIP 2025/26 and 2029/30 delivery programme provided a summary of the projects included in the plan; and
- (6) of the housing supply targets, the strategic housing investment priorities and the scaling up of affordable housing and the delivery of affordable housing in Glasgow.

After consideration, the committee approved the Glasgow Strategic Housing Investment Plan 2025/26 to 2029/30 and its submission to the Scottish Government.
