

Just Transition Implementation Plan – Annual update noted.

5 With reference to the minutes of 27th February 2024 (Print 7, page 66) noting the Just Transition Working Group's Implementation Plan and proposals for reporting back on progress, there was submitted a report by the Director of Regional Economic Growth, advising

- (1) of the actions which had been undertaken by the Council family services and partners in support of each of the 18 recommendations made by the Just Transition Working Group;
- (2) of progress towards the implementation plan which had both sought to influence policies as well as determine where a more applied focus needed to be placed and additional work undertaken;
- (3) that a significant priority had been on engagement with Glaswegian communities to gauge their own sense of what a just transition looked like and to support their own agency in determining how a just future would be brought about;
- (4) that the jobs and skills agenda had a clear and strong significance in ensuring a just transition and giving a tangible sense of the benefits of a greener economy and as such an update on the Just Transition Skills Action Plan be submitted to a future meeting; and
- (5) of the next steps.

After consideration, the committee noted

- (a) the update on the implementation plan for the Just Transition Working Group's recommendations; and
- (b) that an update report on the Just Transition Skills Action Plan would be submitted to a future meeting.
