

Glasgow Transport Strategy - Delivery focus areas approved.

2 With reference to the minutes of the Economy, Housing, Transport and Regeneration City Policy Committee of 19th November 2024 (page 53 hereof) when it was agreed to recommend to this committee approval of the delivery focus for the Glasgow Transport Strategy (GTS), Councillor Miller, City Convener for Climate, Glasgow Green Deal, Transport and City Centre Recovery, presented a report on the matter, advising

- (1) that the delivery focus report would guide the work plan of delivery for the Glasgow Transport Strategy to Spring 2027 and this would be crucial as priorities for transport planning and delivery were agreed upon moving forward;
- (2) that this committee on 10th March 2022 (Print 7, page 509) had approved the GTS which was the Council's overarching policy document on transport issues and aimed to guide and inform decision-making regarding transport in the city and all local authorities in Scotland were expected to produce and regularly update their GTS;
- (3) of the key outputs that had been developed as part of, and to inform, the GTS; and
- (4) that the delivery focus areas for the GTS broadly represented a range of activity underway and planned by the Council and the proposed updated delivery focus areas, as detailed in the report demonstrated that much progress was being made against each of the listed work categories with the Council having a significant programme of work to focus on up to 2027.

After consideration, the committee approved the delivery focus areas for the Glasgow Transport Strategy.
