Glasgow Transport Strategy - Delivery focus areas noted – Recommendation to City Administration Committee.

- There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the progress on the delivery of key transport focus areas for the Glasgow Transport Strategy (GTS), advising
- (1) that the City Administration Committee on 10th March 2022 (Print 7, page 509) had approved the GTS which was the Council's overarching policy document on transport issues and aimed to guide and inform decision-making regarding transport in the city and that all local authorities in Scotland were expected to produce and regularly update their GTS;
- (2) of the key outputs that had been developed as part of, and to inform, the GTS; and
- (3) that the delivery focus areas for the GTS broadly represented a range of activity underway and planned by the Council and demonstrated that much progress was being made against each of the listed work categories with the Council having a significant programme of work to focus on up to 2027.

After consideration and having heard a presentation by Mr Chris Paterson, Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability, the committee

- (a) noted
 - (i) the report and presentation; and
 - (ii) the progress on the delivery of key transport focus areas for the Glasgow Transport Strategy; and
- (b) agreed to recommend to the City Administration Committee approval of the delivery focus areas for the Glasgow Transport Strategy.
