Police Scotland ward update noted etc.

- **5** There was heard a report by Inspector Chris Thomson, Police Scotland advising the Partnership that
- (1) since the last Area Partnership there had been no major incidents in the ward;
- (2) the festive drink and drug driving campaign had commenced;
- (3) they had attended Primary and High Schools in the ward to educate pupils of the dangers of Fireworks, and this had resulted in a reduction of anti-social behaviour on Bonfire night; and
- (4) they were pushing for a resolution with regards to Calton Place and Bridge Street as buildings were lying vacant which resulted in anti-social behaviour within the area, and they were currently working with Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability to clear the area to carry out more surveillance.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report; and
- (b) raised concerns and questions that were addressed by Inspector Thomson, to include speeding cars, illegal parking and concerns of drink and drug driving, which should all be reported to Police Scotland.
