335 Sauchiehall Street (Ward 10) – 24/00014/LOCAL – Use of betting office (Sui Generis) as adult gaming centre (Sui Generis) and external alterations – Application under Section 42 to delete/amend condition 3 of previous consent 20/01876/FUL refused - Dissent.

- With reference to the minutes of 28th May 2024 (Print 2, page 131) continuing consideration for further information from Luxury Leisure a Planning Local Review of a condition relating to planning permission for the use of a betting office (Sui Generis) as an adult gaming centre (Sui Generis) and external alterations at 335 Sauchiehall Street (Ward 10) 24/00014/LOCAL, seeking under Section 42 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 the deletion or amendment of condition 3 of planning permission 20/01876/FUL, there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding information received from the applicant on the following:-
