Strategic Plan Performance - Grand Challenge 1, Missions 2 and 3 - Meet the learning and care needs of children and their families before and through schools and improve the health and wellbeing of our local communities - Service commitments noted.

- With reference to the minutes of 16th November 2022 (Print 4, page 414) noting a performance toolkit that would capture the actions and underpin the Grand Challenges and Missions contained within the Council's Strategic Plan 2022-27, there was submitted a report by the Chief Executive regarding the performance of the commitments that would meet the learning and care needs of children and their families before and through schools and improve the health and wellbeing of our local communities, Missions 2 and 3, advising
- (1) that in order to ensure that the Strategic Plan clearly articulated its purpose, it had been structured into 4 Grand Challenges and their Supporting Missions, as detailed in the report;
- (2) that the Grand Challenges and their Missions were underpinned by Commitments which services were undertaking to work towards meeting the goal of each Mission;
- (3) of the progress made on Grand Challenge 1 Reduce poverty and inequality in our communities and the commitments identified as part of Mission 2: Meet the learning and care needs of children and their families before and through school and Mission 3: Improve the health and wellbeing of our local communities, as detailed in the report; and
- (4) of the next steps.

After consideration, the committee noted the Grand Challenges, Missions and Commitments within the Strategic Plan in respect of Grand Challenge 1 - Missions 2 and 3.
