Introduction of Housing (Scotland) Bill noted.

- There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the introduction of the Housing (Scotland) Bill, advising
- (1) that the Housing (Scotland) Bill had been introduced in the Scottish Parliament on 26th March 2024 and that there were 7 parts outlined in the Bill, as detailed in the report;
- (2) that parts of the Bill aligned with the Housing to 2040 document which set out the Scottish Government's vision for Housing to 2040, including the ambition for everyone to have a safe, good quality and affordable home that met their needs in the place they want to be;
- (3) that the content of the Bill had been informed by 3 public and stakeholder consultations undertaken by the Scottish Government, as detailed in the report and that the Council and the Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership had responded to the New Deal for Tenants and the Prevention of Homelessness Duties consultations; and
- (4) of the key areas of the Bill which would impact on local authorities in terms of statutory duties and resources and of the variety of ways that officers were engaging on the Bill.

After consideration, the committee noted

- (a) the introduction of the Housing (Scotland) Bill by the Scottish Government on 26th March 2024; and
- (b) the next steps to be taken as the Bill progressed to the relevant next stages and considerations.
