

Glasgow Futures Programme – Update noted.

2 There was submitted a report by the Director of Regional Economic Growth regarding an update on the Glasgow Futures programme, advising

- (1) that the Scottish Government's No One Left Behind strategy, formalised in 2018, provided a national framework for transformation of the employability landscape, and marked a step change in the way in which employability provision should be planned for and implemented;
- (2) that the funding landscape for employability provision had changed dramatically and efforts had been made to transition from multiple project specific funding streams towards a more simplified programme, as detailed in the report;
- (3) that the brand for the Glasgow Futures Programme had been developed with service users to embody a coherent image, culture and personality and using the Scottish Approach to Service Design, the new employability programme had been developed by the Council's Centre for Civic Innovation, as detailed in the report;
- (4) of the work in relation to the Glasgow Futures Quality Standard, The Glasgow Guarantee, Partnership Action for Continuing Employment, the Local Employability Partnership, Skills Development and Adult Learning and the Child Poverty Pathfinder; and
- (5) of the next steps.

After consideration, the committee noted the report and that reports on the progress of the Glasgow Futures Programme would be submitted to this committee.
