

**Glasgow City Council – City Centre Enabling Infrastructure Integrated Public Realm project – Sauchiehall Street West – Full Business Case approved etc – Declaration of interest.**

5 With reference to the minutes of 12th December 2016 approving the Outline Business Case in respect of the City Centre Enabling Infrastructure Integrated Public Realm project, there was submitted a report by the Director of the Programme Management Office (PMO) intimating that Glasgow City Council had submitted a Full Business Case in respect of the Sauchiehall Street West aspect of the project, which, following evaluation by the PMO, had been considered and approved by the Chief Executives' Group on 24th May 2017 and was now being submitted to Cabinet for approval, advising

- (1) that the executive summary of the project, detailed in Appendix 1 of the report, described the strategic case, the preferred option, its affordability, environmental sustainability, procurement strategy and management arrangements;
- (2) that the project had been reviewed against the business case criteria outlined within the Glasgow City Region City Deal Business Case Guidance Template;
- (3) of the project risk register, as detailed in Appendix 2 of the report;
- (4) of the funding requirements as detailed; and
- (5) of the current benefits realisation requirements being met by this project.

After consideration and having heard a presentation on the project by J Laiolo, Glasgow City Council, the Cabinet

- (a) agreed that Glasgow City Council be invited to proceed to delivery monitoring and evaluation of the project;
- (b) noted
  - (i) that Glasgow City Council would take cognisance of the Programme Business Case and contribute towards delivering the outcomes of the programme which would be represented in future iterations of the Programme Business Case; and
  - (ii) the executive summary and project risk register detailed in Appendices 1 and 2 respectively of the report; and
- (c) approved the funding requirement of £6.751m.

Councillor Aitken declared an interest in this item and took no part in the discussion or decision thereon.
