

“Green Recovery” – Submission to the Scottish Parliament’s Environment, Climate Change and Land Reform Committee noted.

10 There was submitted and noted a report by the Chief Executive, East Dunbartonshire Council, inviting the Cabinet to note the submission, developed by Climate Ready Clyde on behalf of Glasgow City Region, to the Scottish Parliament’s Environment, Climate Change and Land Reform Committee, which had issued a call for evidence in relation to a ‘Green Recovery’, advising

- (1) that the Committee had issued a call for evidence on the 26th June 2020 as part of its inquiry to establish the principles that should underpin a green recovery, to identify key actions for change, immediate priorities, potential barriers to implementation and the governance arrangements needed to deliver this;
- (2) that the response had been prepared by Climate Ready Clyde, in consultation with the Glasgow City Region Programme Management Office (PMO) and the Portfolio Lead for Land Use and Sustainability;
- (3) of the response as detailed in Appendix 1 of the report which reflected the key questions that the Committee had asked to be addressed; and
- (4) that the report had been approved by the Regional Partnership on 30th July 2020 and had been submitted to the consultation by the deadline of 7th August 2020.
