

## **Scottish Government Town Centre Capital fund 2019/20 and 2020/21 – Progress noted.**

**6** With reference to the minutes of the City Administration Committee of 28th January 2021 (Print 4, page 214) approving the allocation of funds from the Scottish Government Town Centre Capital fund 2019/20 and 2020/21, there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the current progress, advising

- (1) that in March 2019, the Scottish Government, in partnership with COSLA had announced a £50m fund to help boost Scottish Town Centres and Glasgow's allocation of this fund was £3.01m, with 12 projects within the 3 thematic headings, as detailed in the report, having been identified for funding;
- (2) of the progress of the Town Centre Capital Fund programme for 2020/21; and
- (3) of the opportunities and priorities for future rounds of funding from the Scottish Government Town Centre Capital Fund.

After consideration, the committee noted

- (a) the progress with the implementation of the Town Centre Fund 2019/20 and 2020/21 programmes; and
- (b) the priorities and opportunities for future Town Centre capital funding to best align with the Council's corporate aims.
