## COP26 legacy noted.

- There was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the role of this committee in developing a legacy for COP26, the 26th United Nations Climate Change Conference, advising
- (1) that following postponement of the conference in 2020 due to COVID-19, COP26 was now due to run from 1st to 12th November 2021 at the Scottish Event Campus and the intent remained to hold the summit in person, whilst putting the health and wellbeing of local communities and delegations at the centre of decisions about how the event would take shape;
- (2) that Glasgow's focus for COP26 was on supporting and delivering a safe and successful conference by keeping the city moving, supporting the appropriate public health measures and delivering a legacy for the city; and
- (3) of this committee's current and future key workstreams that would contribute towards the development of a COP26 legacy and that the committee would be required to reflect further upon its role in developing a COP26 legacy once the agreements/actions from the COP26 events were known.
