

Area Budget 2021/22 – Applications for Funding dealt with etc.

6 With reference to the minutes of the City Administration Committee of 29th August 2019, when the committee approved the proposed budget for the Glasgow Communities Fund for the next three financial years, there was submitted a report by the Council's Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities regarding the Area Budget for 2021/22, advising of the current position in relation to the proposed Area Budget allocation and applications for funding for 2021/22, including information regarding travel passes and playschemes within the Ward area, and that it was anticipated that the Council would set its budget, early in 2021, for the financial year 2021/22.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (1) noted
 - (a) the current Glasgow City Council budget position in relation to the proposed Area Budget allocations for 2021/22;
 - (b) the current position on awarding funds from the 2021/22 allocation;
 - (c) that time critical awards for up to £500 could be allocated from the 2021/22 budget under existing Delegated Authority arrangements;
 - (d) that proposals for the allocation of playscheme funding for summer and October 2021 would be submitted to the next meeting of the Area Partnership for approval and the changes to the travel pass scheme for 2021.
- (2) approved the proposal for awards to playschemes for the spring break to be considered in March 2021 under Delegated Functions to enable funding to be released prior to the next meeting of the Area Partnership;
- (3) dealt with the application for funding as follows, the grant award being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:-
