

**Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund (NIIF) - Community Engagement update noted etc – Request to Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability.**

4 With reference to the minutes of 22nd April 2025 providing an update on Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund (NIIF) Community Engagement, there was submitted a report by the Head of Policy and Corporate Governance providing additional ideas for funding as detailed in an appendix to the report.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report;
- (b) agreed that 5 proposals, should go forward to the next stage to be assessed and costed by Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability
  - (i) 1A - Broomhouse – Glasgow City Council to purchase, erect and maintain 3 new radar speed signs;
  - (ii) 1B - Wellhouse – Wellhouse Housing Association – to upgrade and renew full stair and hand rails at steps leading from Balado Road to Newhills Road and install enhanced lighting, plant trees and cut back old ones;
  - (iii) 1D, 1E, 1G - Baillieston – Baillieston Community Council – a 5ft metal fence to go around the community garden, 2 pedestrian guardrails at Gardner's Lane, Church Street and CCTV at 70 Old Wood Road;
- (c) agreed to defer proposal 1C – Baillieston signage and other signage in the ward area to a later date when the above priority proposals had been costed; and
- (d) requested that the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability investigate proposal 1F – playpark renewal funding subject to an ownership check.
