## Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund (NIIF) - Community Engagement update noted etc – Request to Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability.

With reference to the minutes of 22nd April 2025 providing an update on Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund (NIIF) Community Engagement, there was submitted a report by the Head of Policy and Corporate Governance providing additional ideas for funding as detailed in an appendix to the report.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report;
- (b) agreed that 5 proposals, should go forward to the next stage to be assessed and costed by Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability
  - 1A Broomhouse Glasgow City Council to purchase, erect and maintain 3 new radar speed signs;
  - (ii) 1B Wellhouse Wellhouse Housing Association to upgrade and renew full stair and hand rails at steps leading from Balado Road to Newhills Road and install enhanced lighting, plant trees and cut back old ones;
  - (iii) 1D, 1E, 1G Baillieston Baillieston Community Council a 5ft metal fence to go around the community garden, 2 pedestrian guardrails at Gardner's Lane, Church Street and CCTV at 70 Old Wood Road;
- (c) agreed to defer proposal 1C Baillieston signage and other signage in the ward area to a later date when the above priority proposals had been costed; and
- (d) requested that the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability investigate proposal 1F playpark renewal funding subject to an ownership check.
