01	The proposed project is located at Abernethy Street play park situated in the Haghill area of Dennistoun. The park which lies within one of the most deprived areas in Scotland according to the latest SIMD (Scottish index of multiple deprivation) statistics has seen no significant investment in over 30 years. Despite its outdated and worn play equipment the park remains a well used space by local families and children. The site has also been utilised by a number of third sector organisations over the years for outdoor activities and park-based programmes. 	immediately adjacent to Bluevale Neighbourhood Centre, it is ideally placed to support integrated community engagement. This proposal seeks investment to upgrade the existing play equipment, which is no longer fit for purpose. Although improvements have been proposed in the past, and previous assurances of investment were made, no meaningful changes have materialised.	
	Local families continue to rely on the park as one of the few accessible outdoor spaces in the area, and there is a clear need for modern, safe, and inclusive play facilities that reflect the needs of the community. This has been a consistent request during our regular consultations, with local residents often describing the park as an "eyesore." Parents frequently remark that it has not changed since they were young.
