

## **Police Scotland ward update noted – Request to Police Scotland.**

**8** There was heard a report by Inspector Stephen Gow, Police Scotland, advising the Partnership

- (1) that officers continued to work with the major supermarkets to combat shoplifting and that alcohol to order shoplifting and fuel theft had increased;
- (2) that a road traffic day of action had been held on 11th September with enforcement action against illegal e-bikes and motorbikes being the main issues;
- (3) that there had been a decrease in youth disorder and anti-social behaviour incidents;
- (4) of a successful Day of Action that had focussed on speeding in various areas in the ward and that specific areas could be targeted if requested;
- (5) of youth diversionary activities organised by Police Scotland which had been well attended; and
- (6) of the joint partnership between Trading Standards and Police Scotland to highlights scams and frauds to reach those who did not use social media with officers attending the Fort with a “Scam Van” to highlight whatsapp and texting scams.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted and thanked Inspector Gow for the update;
- (b) highlighted concerns regarding cold calling at residents’ homes and a caravan blocking Gartloch Road; and
- (c) requested that Police Scotland update their social media to publicise their presence in the ward.
