4. LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 – REVIEW OF PILOT SCHEME – 1AM TERMINAL HOUR FOR ON SALE PREMISES IN THE CITY CENTRE

The Board determined to extend the 1am terminal hour for On Sales Premises in the City Centre under the following terms:

- All premises which were initially granted a terminal licensed hour of 1am as part of the pilot shall continue with existing conditions, revised to remove the words "for a 12-month period" and compliance with the 1am criteria detailed within the policy statement.
- Applications for major variations in respect of City Centre On Sales Premises wishing to apply for a terminal hour of 1am will be considered on its own individual merits.
