Application for the Grant of a Temporary Public Entertainment Licence

Applicant: MT Attractions Limited

Address: Site bounded by South Street/Ferryden Road, Glasgow Ward: 12

Recommendation:

The Committee may grant the licence.

Conditions:

- 1. Suitable provisions should be made for variances in ground conditions.
- 2. Provide an Event Management Plan.
- 3. Provide a Wind Management Plan.
- 4. Provide an evacuation plan indication emergency exits.
- 5. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.
- 6. Fixed counter installations such as a serving counter in a reception desk, bar or restaurant should be accessible to a person who is standing, regardless of stature, or seated in a wheelchair.
- 7. Section 89 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 approval for any structure 600mm and greater above ground level is required.
- 8. A limited life Building warrant will be required to have a completion certificate accepted for all structures greater than 30m² and erected for a period of greater than 28 days.
- 9. A final inspection will be required prior to the release of the licence.

It is proposed to hold a Christmas themed event within the vacant site on South Street/Ferryden Street 24th November- 4th January 2026 between 10am and 10pm

The Capacity of the event is 2750 persons.

Christmas Tree maze
Market
