Recommendation:

The Committee may grant the licence.

Conditions:

- 1. A Building Warrant and Completion Certificate are required for the permanent structures with the site.
- 2. Suitable provisions should be made for variances in ground conditions.
- 3. Provide a Wind Management Plan
- 4. Stalls or lightweight structures to be suitably fixed down to prevent uplift due to wind loadings.
- 5. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.

Background Information:

It is proposed to hold an outdoor market within the development at the Kelvin walkway for 42 stances between 7am and 8pm

The capacity of the site is 250 persons.
