Conditions:

- 1. The premises should have a current emergency lighting test certificate BS 5266.
- 2. The premises should have a current electrical installation test certificate BS 7671 or a current Periodic Inspection report for the electrical installation BS 7671
- 3. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.
- 4. The premises should have an appropriate Fire Risk Assessment.

Background Information:

It is proposed to use the main games hall within Bellahouston Leisure Centre for the purpose of an Indoor Market on the 1st Saturday and Sunday of the month between 10am and 3pm. This will include a maximum of 77 stalls. The capacity is 300 persons for this event.
