

Scottish Fire and Rescue Service ward update noted.

5 There was submitted a report by Station Commander Douglas Miller, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (SFRS) regarding the current issues, incidents and work being carried out in the ward for Quarter 3, from 1st October to 31st December 2025, advising the Partnership

- (1) that the service had attended 652 incidents in the South area that included 145 fires, 161 non-fire incidents and 228 false alarms, 71 Unwanted Fire Alarm Signals (UFAS) with 3 non-fire fatalities recorded;
- (2) of the 8 road traffic collisions in the South Area, there was 1 non-fatal casualty and 2 people rescued by firefighters;
- (3) of the accidental dwelling fire casualties of which 5 were non-fatal casualties and 2 people were rescued by firefighters;
- (4) that there had been 297 Home Fire Safety Visits and 50 Fire safety audits completed in the South Area; and
- (5) that a new safety campaign “Take Charge Glasgow” had been launched for batteries, vapes, or small electrical items, that these items should be taken to designated recycling points at shops, electrical retailers, or council waste centres to be safely disposed of and Information can be found at <https://www.glasgow.gov.uk/batteries> .
