Recommendation:

The Committee may grant the licence.

Conditions:

1. Confirmation that the site is suitable for Large Adult Fairground Rides
2. Suitable provisions should be made for variances in ground conditions.
3. Provide an Event Management Plan
4. Provide a Wind Management Plan
5. Provide calculations for how the capacity has been calculated
6. Indicate how the site is enclosed
7. Indicate the location of the emergency exits and lighting of exit signs
8. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.
9. Section 89 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 approval for any structure 600mm and greater above ground level is required.

Background Information:

It is proposed to form a fairground, market and entertainment area with live music and bars with the roadway and within the adjacent dog park on the 12th to the 21st September between 11am and 11pm

The capacity of the event is 100 persons

The event will consist of

- 8 Adult Rides
- 12 Kids Rides
- 1 Zip line
- 23 Market Stalls
- 5 Food stall
- 1 Stage
- 2 Bars
