Regional Economic Strategy Action Plan for Inverclyde approved.

- 10 With reference to the minutes of the Cabinet of 25th February 2025 agreeing that Inverclyde be identified as a regional priority and instructing the Glasgow City Region Programme Management Office (PMO) to engage with Inverclyde Council to identify specific additional actions for inclusion within the Regional Economic Strategic (RES) Action Plan, there was submitted a report by the Director of Regional Economic Growth regarding the inclusion of new actions within the RES, advising
- (1) that discussions had taken place between Glasgow City Region (PMO) and the Intelligence Hub with Inverclyde Council to identify and develop new actions for inclusion within the RES Action Plan, that would provide a specific focus on addressing the challenges faced in Inverclyde;
- (2) that a number of initial RES actions had been identified to support Inverclyde and of the 6 proposed actions, as detailed in the report; and
- (3) of the support from members of the Glasgow City Regional Partnership that had discussed their role or actions their organisations could make to help address the challenges faced by Inverclyde and of the responses, as detailed in the report.

After consideration, the Cabinet

- (a) noted the report; and
- (b) approved the inclusion of the new actions relating to Inverclyde within the RES Action Plan.
