Police Scotland ward update noted.

- 7 There was heard and noted a report by Inspector Stephen Gow, Police Scotland, advising the Partnership
- (1) that officers continued to work with the major supermarkets to combat shoplifting and that alcohol to order shoplifting had increased;
- (2) that a road traffic day of action had been held on 11th September with enforcement action against illegal e-bikes and speeding being the main issues;
- (3) that there had been a decrease in youth disorder and anti-social behaviour incidents;
- (4) of youth diversionary activities organised by Police Scotland which had been well attended; and
- (5) of the joint partnership between Trading Standards and Police Scotland to highlights scams and frauds to reach those who did not use social media with a "Scam Van" at various sites.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted and thanked Inspector Gow for the update;
- (b) raised a number of concerns and questions that were answered by Inspector Gow; and
- (c) requested that officers visit Fuse Café when the youth clubs were taking place to engage more with the young people in the Ward.
