

Local Parks and Open Space Improvement Fund update noted etc – Request to Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability.

7 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability, regarding an update on the Local Parks and Open Space Improvement Fund and the Scottish Government Play Area Renewal programme,

- (1) advising that the Council had allocated £3m of funding to Area Partnerships for investment in Local Parks and Open Space for 2021/22 and 2022/23; and
- (1) providing an update and progress on projects allocated within the ward for years 2021/22 and 2022/23, as detailed in the report; and
- (2) summarising the play areas identified for renewal works for funding from the Scottish Government Play Area Renewal programme, as detailed in the report.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted
 - (i) the report;
 - (ii) the 2021/22 and 2022/23 projects that had now been completed, as detailed in the report;
 - (iii) the 3 projects that had still to be completed, as detailed in the report; and
- (b) requested the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability to
 - (i) revisit the Budhill Play Area in relation to the gate opening the wrong way and Danny's Park in relation to there being no resurfacing works done, the removal of a fallen tree and that soft landscaping had not been carried out; and
 - (ii) provide information in relation to the ongoing project at Barlanark MUGGA and further information in relation to Strone Road Playpark, Barlanark Park, Greenfield Park, Barlanark Small Playpark, Cranhill Park and the Sensory Garden located at the Cranhill Water Tower, as detailed in the report and the further comments made at the meeting.
