

**Area Budget 2015/16 – Monitoring statement and applications for funding dealt with.**

**10** There was submitted a report by the Acting Executive Director of Corporate Services detailing applications for funding from Calton Area Budget 2015/16.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (1) noted that, to date, £18,411 had been allocated to various projects in the Calton Ward, leaving a balance of £46,849; and
- (2) dealt with the applications for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:-
