

CALTON AREA PARTNERSHIP.

Minutes of meeting held on 5th August 2015 in the City Chambers, Glasgow.

Minutes of previous meeting approved.

1 The minutes of 20th May 2015 were submitted and approved subject to the inclusion of Kelly Glass, Voluntary Sector Network (in conjunction with the Third Sector Forum) in the present section of the sederunt.

Prosecuting Drug Related Offences noted.

2 With reference to the minutes of 20th May 2015, when the Partnership requested the Procurator Fiscal submit a report detailing the process for prosecuting drug related offences, there was heard and noted the relevant verbal input by Paul Reynolds, Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service.

Community Payback Services noted.

3 With reference to the minutes of 20th May 2015, when the Partnership requested the Managing Director of Community Safety Glasgow to submit a report regarding the Community Payback scheme, there was submitted and noted the relevant report by the Managing Director of Community Safety Glasgow, advising

- (1) Community Safety Glasgow (CSG) provided 384 unpaid work squad placements per week on behalf of Glasgow City Council Criminal Justice Social Work Services;
- (2) unpaid work was one of the nine requirements available to sentencers as part of a Community Payback Order ;

- (3) of the CSG nomination process;
- (4) of the various variables used to prioritise projects; and
- (5) of the unpaid work activity carried out within Ward 9 from 1st April 2014 until 31st March 2015.

Neighbourhood Management - Anti-social Behaviour update noted.

4 With reference to the minutes of 3rd December 2014, when the Partnership agreed the short/medium and long term outcomes, actions, timescales and Area Partnership leads for the Anti-Social Behaviour Action Plan, there was submitted and noted a report by the Chief Constable, Police Scotland advising of the progress made in relation to the Anti-social Behaviour outcomes, as detailed in the report.

Integrated Grant Fund Review - Area Budget noted.

5 There was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Corporate Services regarding the Integrated Grant Fund Review Area Budget, advising of

- (1) the proposals approved by The Council's Executive Committee on 25th June 2015 in relation to the Integrated Grant Fund Area Budget as detailed in the appendix 1 of the report;
- (2) the approved recommendations for implementation which had been developed based on the majority views of those who participated in the consultation undertaken, as follows:-
 - (a) investment strategy;
 - (b) eligibility criteria;
 - (c) minimum and maximum awards;
 - (d) eligibility of public sector applications;
 - (e) application process;
 - (f) delegated authority;
 - (g) community budgeting; and

After consideration, the Partnership noted

- (i) the approval of the Integrated Grant Fund Review Area Budget proposals by the Council's Executive Committee and the timetable for implementation;

- (ii) the actions that will be undertaken by Corporate Services staff to support the implementation of the agreed recommendations; and
- (iii) the requirement of the Area Partnership to agree its key investment priorities for implementation from 1st April 2016.

Area Budget 2015/16 – Budget allocations noted – Applications for funding dealt with.

6 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Corporate Services detailing applications for funding from Calton Area Budget 2015/16.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (1) noted that, to date, £13,118 had been allocated to various projects in the Calton Ward, leaving a balance of £52,142; and
- (2) dealt with the applications for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:-
