

### **John Wheatley Learning Network noted.**

**3** There was submitted a report by C Green, Glasgow Kelvin College informing the Partnership of the developments within the Ward relating to the John Wheatley Learning Network, advising

- (1) that the John Wheatley Learning Network was a unique collaboration in which the learning centres were hosted by independent organisations and were supported by Glasgow Kelvin College which delivered to the host organisations;
- (2) that there were currently 35 community based learning centres, 30 of which were in the North East of Glasgow;
- (3) of the learning centres within the Calton Ward, which were located at
  - (a) Bridgeton Community Learning Campus;
  - (b) Lodging House Mission;
  - (c) Helenvale Learning Centre;
  - (d) G31 Centre;
  - (e) the Legacy Hub (new);
  - (f) the Enterprise Centre (new); and
- (4) of the main elements of the North East Learning Programme:-
  - (i) John Wheatley Learning Network;
  - (ii) Wider Access Programme;
  - (iii) Youth Access Programme; and
  - (iv) Community Achievement Programme.

After consideration, the Partnership noted the report and expressed thanks to the Learning Network for their work within the Ward.
