

Sustainable Glasgow - Energy and Carbon Masterplan emissions reduction target – Update noted.

5 With reference to the minutes of the Executive Committee of 2nd April 2015 (Print 1, page 11) approving the Energy and Carbon Masterplan for the city, there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Land and Environmental Services regarding the progress of the Energy and Carbon Masterplan's 30% emissions reduction target by 2020 on a 2006 baseline, advising

- (1) that the Department for Energy and Climate Change (DECC) released data on energy consumption and carbon emissions for Local Authorities across the UK on an annual basis, which provided figures 2 years in arrears;
- (2) of the initiatives in place that worked towards the reduction of carbon emissions within Glasgow;
- (3) of the results of Glasgow's energy consumption analysis and CO₂ emissions over the 2 year period including comparison with the other 31 Scottish Local Authority areas;
- (4) of the significant projects included within the Energy and Carbon Masterplan; and
- (5) that the Council would join other cities around the UK and the world in signing up to a pledge which would commit Glasgow to a 100% clean energy supply by 2050.

After consideration, the committee

- (a) noted the report and progress being made towards the 2020 emissions reduction target; and
- (b) supported continued debate on setting ambitions for 2030 and beyond.
