

**Roads infrastructure annual status and options report noted, after division -  
Instruction to Executive Director of Land and Environmental Services.**

**2** There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Land and Environmental Services regarding the status of the roads infrastructure, including investment options, advising

- (1) that the Annual Status and Options Report was a product of the Road Asset Management Plan and recorded the level of service that the Council was aiming to achieve and provided a means of identifying and prioritising the overall funding needs of the Council's road assets; and
- (2) of the current status, key issues and predicted impact that differing levels of investment would have on the Council's road assets as contained in the Annual Status and Options Report 2015 detailed at Appendix 1 of the report.

Councillor Turner, seconded by Councillor Hanif, moved that the committee note

- (a) the Annual Status and Options Report; and
- (b) that the Clyde Valley Roads Alliance Group, chaired by this Council, would continue to identify collaboration opportunities.

Councillor Carey, seconded by Councillor McKeever, moved as an amendment that the committee

- (a) note
  - (i) the Annual Status and Options Report; and
  - (ii) that the Clyde Valley Roads Alliance Group, chaired by this Council, would continue to identify collaboration opportunities; and
- (b) instruct the Executive Director of Land and Environmental Services to approach the Scottish Government regarding the ongoing and future funding of the Clyde Tunnel and its approaches (including the Shieldhall viaduct).

On a vote being taken electronically, 6 members voted for the amendment and 5 for the motion. The amendment was accordingly declared to be carried.
