Street trading in that area of the City of Glasgow bounded by and including the whole of Clyde Street, Broomielaw, York Street, Argyle Street, Pitt Street, St. Vincent Street, North Street, Sauchiehall Street, St. George's Road, Renfrew Street, Cambridge Street, Cowcaddens Road, North Hanover Street, Cathedral Street, North Frederick Path, North Frederick Street, George Square, George Street, High Street, Bell Street, Hunter Street, Bain Street, London Road, Greendyke Street and Saltmarket, shall take place only at fixed stances as designated in the relevant street trader's licence.
