

Sustainable Glasgow Partnership update noted etc.

2 With reference to the minutes of 27th May 2025 (Print 2, page 141) noting the progress on the Sustainable Glasgow Partnership (SGP), there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability, advising that

- (1) SGP was established in 2009 to support Glasgow to reduce its Scope 1 and 2 carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions by 30% by 2020 against a baseline of 2006 and the SGP was relaunched in 2019 and had evolved since its creation strengthening its commitment to support Glasgow on its journey to be climate-resilient and become a Net Zero Carbon city by 2030;
- (2) the SGP was restructured in 2024, with the Glasgow Sustainable Board (SGB) comprising of 9 members and remained unchanged, as detailed in the report; and
- (3) the SGB had facilitated progress in a number of different areas and this progress could be measured through the work of the thematic hubs and further activities as well as through the SGB together with the next steps, as detailed in the report.

After consideration, the committee noted that a further update would be provided to this committee.
