
Museum Association Criteria for reason for dispersal

- Object no longer fits with GM Collecting Policy
- Unlikely that object will go on display or be researched in next 10-15yrs
- It's more suitable for another Museum/Heritage service collection
- object is a duplicate (others have better provenance/stories)
- object is in poor condition and beyond reasonable repair
- object poses a threat to health and safety
- object has no provenance or contextual information
