Can an update be provided regarding the provision of public toilets within parks, particularly in relation to Glasgow Green and Tollcross Park?

**Answer**

**Glasgow Green**

A temporary modular unit has been installed at Glasgow Green (near Greendyke Street entrance).

This is likely to remain on hire until at least October 2027 (subject to a hire extension currently in development).

The unit at Glasgow Green was revenue funded and not through the Place Fund; It is paid for as a hire through the existing Healthmatic contract (i.e. as a variation to that contract).

**Tollcross Winter Gardens**

The council has entered into contract with Healthmatic to purchase and install a small freestanding toilet block housing two toilets which will support the use of the restored Tollcross Glasshouse – refurbishment works were completed in 2023. The works to install the new toilet block are hoped to be completed by July 2026.

These toilet facilities are for exclusive use by patrons of the glasshouse; there is no usage charge, however access will be controlled by keypad.
