AREA BUDGET 2025/26: APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING.

Purpose of Report:
To provide the Area Partnership with details of the current position of the 2025/26 Area Budget and inform members of applications considered under Delegated Functions.

Introduction.

1. This report provides details on the Area Partnership's budget position for 2025/26; any applications considered under Delegated Functions; and makes recommendations on further funding applications.

Background.

2. Glasgow City Council agreed its budget for 2025/26 on 13th February 2025 with the overall funding available for Area Partnerships maintained at 2024/25 levels. The City Administration Committee approved allocations to Area Partnership on 13th March 2025. The Victoria Park Area Budget for 2025/26 is £59,733.00.
3. The Victoria Park Area Partnership has committed a total of £58,280.00 (97.6%) to various projects, leaving a balance of £1,453.00(2.4%).
