Recommendation:

The Committee may grant the licence.

Conditions:

1. Suitable provisions should be made for variances in ground conditions.
2. Provide an Event Management Plan.
3. Provide a Wind Management Plan.
4. Provide an evacuation plan indication emergency exits.
5. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.
6. Fixed counter installations such as a serving counter in a reception desk, bar or restaurant should be accessible to a person who is standing, regardless of stature, or seated in a wheelchair.
7. Section 89 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 approval for any structure 600mm and greater above ground level is required.
8. A final inspection will be required prior to the release of the licence.

Background Information:

It is proposed to hold a family event within the vacant site on South Street/Ferryden Street 27th March- 19th April 2026 between 10am and 10pm

The Capacity of the event is 3350 persons.

The event will consist of the following

- 37 rides
- 10 food units
- 2 bar units
- 15 game units
- Drive in cinema
- Ice Rink
- Circus
- 2 Marques
