Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund (NIIF) – Community Council allocations and proposals.

Purpose of Report:

To provide the Area Partnership with details of NIIF allocations to community councils in the Langside Ward based on the agreed split between population and Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation (SIMD); and to consider NIIF funding proposals from Community Councils.

Recommendations:

The Area Partnership is asked to:

- (1) Note the NIIF allocations to Community Councils, as detailed in Appendix 1; and
- (2) consider proposals received from community councils in the Langside Ward, as summarised in Appendix 3.

Background.

1. The Langside Area Partnership agreed on 3rd February 2026 to allocate NIIF funding to community council areas in the Ward based on a 60/40 split between population and SIMD respectively.
2. The Area Partnership also asked that community councils prioritise their proposals to facilitate spending decisions.

Funding allocations to community council areas.

3. The Area Partnership agreed to allocate NIIF funding to community councils in the area on the basis of 60% population and 40% SIMD, including those community council areas with a physical presence in the Langside Ward but no representation on the Langside Area Partnership.
4. The allocations are attached in **Appendix 1**.

Proposals for NIIF funding.

5. The Partnership has been considering proposals for NIIF funding generated by local communities on an ongoing basis. A number of proposals have been approved by the Area Partnership and these are summarised in **Appendix 2** with further details included in the accompanying report from NRS. Some proposals have been costed by NRS and are subject to decisions by the Area Partnership. Other proposals have still to be agreed by the Area Partnership to go forward to the next stage to be assessed and costed by NRS and brought to a future meeting for consideration. These are summarised in **Appendix 3**, in priority order where community councils have provided priorities.

Recommendations.

6. The Area Partnership is asked to:
 - (1) Note the NIIF allocations to Community Councils; and
 - (2) consider proposals received from community councils in the Langside Ward, as summarised in Appendix 3.
