**Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund (NIIF) – Community engagement update.**

**Purpose of Report:**

To provide the Area Partnership with a list of ideas for funding from the NIIF that have been submitted by Carmyle Re-run for the Carmyle area of the ward.

**Recommendations:**

The Area Partnership is asked to:

- (1) note the current position; and
- (2) consider the ideas attached, in conjunction with the ideas that have already been costed or approved (see Item 4 on the agenda) and agree how it wants to proceed.

## **Introduction.**

1. The purpose of this paper is to bring ideas for spending NIF, that have been generated by communities, to the Area Partnership for consideration. Those ideas that the Area Partnership wishes to go forward to the next stage will be assessed and costed by Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability (NRS) and brought to a future meeting when the Area Partnership will be asked to allocate funding.

## **Next stages of NIF.**

2. Previous community consultation was undertaken and ideas were generated and submitted to previous meetings of this Area Partnership however no ideas were submitted for the Carmyle area. At the last meeting of the Area Partnership it was agreed that further consultation should take place with Carmyle Re-run to generate ideas for the Camyle area.
3. The attached is a collated list of all those ideas that have been gathered for the Carmyle area. The Area Partnership now needs to look at these ideas alongside those previously agreed for costing in other parts of the ward and decide which of these ideas to submit to NRS for costing.
