1. LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 – LICENSING BOARD EQUALITY OUTCOMES 2025-2029

6. LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 – GENERAL EXTENSION OF LICENSED HOURS WORLD CUP 2026

The Board agreed to vary the order of business and there was a report submitted by the Clerk to the Licensing Board.

After consideration, the Board determined to grant a general extension until 30 minutes after the final whistle/end of play of a live World Cup 2026 football match where it is being shown within the licensed premises, beyond the terminal hour to all licensed premises with an on-sales facility that have televised sport within its operating plan, from 11 June 2026 to 19 July 2026 (both dates inclusive), with the condition detailed below and subject to the Specific Exclusions mentioned at Section Two of the Festive Policy.

Where licensed premises are open after 12 Midnight by virtue of the general extension provided, such premises will be expected to comply with the Licensing Board's policy relative to the use of toughened glass, any other recognised safety products in licensed premises as set out in part 10 of its [Policy Statement \(PDF, 5 MB\)](#)[\(opens new window\)](#) and any other conditions attached to the operation of the licensed premises.

Condition:

The licence holder shall have a written policy setting out transport arrangements in regard to staff being able to commute home safely from the licensed premises.
