Should the application be granted, the following condition should be applied –

1. All waste materials generated from the business require to be uplifted and disposed of by a registered waste contractor, and records of the volume and type of waste made available for inspection by an authorised officer. Such records should be retained for a period of two years.
2. That noise from the venue shall not give rise to a Statutory Noise Nuisance in domestic dwellings (as defined in section 79 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990).
3. That plant, machinery or equipment associated with the event shall be designed and/or attenuated such that, within any noise-sensitive premises, it shall not give rise to a noise level exceeding Noise Rating Curve 25 between the hours of 23:00 and 07:00 and Noise Rating Curve 35 at all other times.
