Cardonald 2025/26 Area Budget: Applications for Funding

Purpose of Report:

To provide the Area Partnership with details of the current position of the 2024/25 Area Budget; inform members of applications considered under Delegated Functions; and make recommendations on further applications for funding.

1. Introduction

1.1 This report provides details on the area budget allocations for 2025/26, funding allocated to date, informs the Partnership on funding applications considered under Delegated Functions; and makes recommendations on further Area Budget funding applications.

2. 2025/26 Area Budget Allocation

2.1 Glasgow City Council agreed its budget for 2025/26 on 13th February 2025 with overall funding available for Area Partnerships maintained at 2024/25 levels. The City Administration Committee approved allocations to Area Partnerships on 13th March 2025. The annual allocation for Cardonald Area Budget is **£67,115**.

3. Area Budget Expenditure to Date

3.1 To date, Cardonald Area Partnership has committed a total of **£67,115 (100%)** to various projects in the area within which **£2,023** was allocated via the Delegated Authority Function.

3.2 A balance of **£0 (0%)** remains unallocated. Appendix 1 provides details of the allocations to date.
