Along with the above accessioned material we also have collections of items that were previously used as display set-dressings, used by the learning and access teams across several venues or were items deposited anonymously that were not accessioned. Our curatorial have checked all these items for potential acquisition.

Items include:

- Glass and ceramics
- Textiles (clothing, lace)
- Toys and games (vintage jigsaws)

We have previously given bags of clothing to various charity shops and craft items to local community groups. We have also contacted other local museum services if we felt they would be interested in any of the dispersals.
