1 Background

- 1.1 Holmblue Limited were granted a Sexual Entertainment Venue licence in respect of premises known as Seventh Heaven, 95 Hope Street, Glasgow on 30 August 2023 with a commencement date of 27 September 2023 and with an expiry date of 31 August 2026 subject to the conditions contained within the licence.
- 1.2 A request has been received from Mr Andrew Cox on behalf of Holmblue Limited for approval of advertising for Seventh Heaven, 95 Hope Street in terms of condition 1 to their Sexual Entertainment Venue licence, a copy of which is attached at Appendix 1 to this report.

Condition 1 to a Sexual Entertainment Venue licence is noted below for Members' information:-

External Appearance of the Venue and Public Displays of Information

The Licence holder shall ensure:

1. That there is to be no advertisement or promotional material used by the venue on the exterior of the venue that has any "display of nudity" as defined under the 1982 Act. The licence holder shall ensure that any exterior signage is discreet and must not display any nudity imagery that suggests or indicates relevant sexual entertainment takes place within the venue. Any external displays or advertising may only be displayed with the prior written approval of the Local Authority.
