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Area Budget 2026/27: Applications for Funding.

Purpose of Report:

To provide the Area Partnership with details of the area budget allocations for 2026/27, the current budget position and to make recommendations on new applications for funding.

Recommendations:

Introduction.

1. Glasgow City Council set its budget for 2026/27 on [24 February 2026](#). Within the budget, the overall funding for Area Partnerships was increased by £63,000, to be apportioned on the basis of the SIMD (Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation).
2. On [12th March 2026](#), the Council's City Administration Committee approved allocations to Area Partnerships. The East Centre Area Budget for 2026/27 is £119,553.00.

East Centre Area Budget 2026/27.

3. This Area Partnership committed £24,159.00 at its meeting on 01 April 2026 from the 2026/27 Area Budget. In £4,433.00 addition has been committed under the scheme of Delegated Functions.
4. Therefore, a total of £28,592.00 has been committed to date to various projects serving the East Centre Ward, leaving a balance of £90,961.00 yet to be allocated.
