

Public Procession Annual Report 2025/26 noted.

2 There was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Legal and Administration regarding an annual report on public procession notifications submitted to the Council for the period from 1st April 2025 to 31st March 2026, advising

- (1) that the legal and administrative process for dealing with notifications for public processions in Scotland was set out in Part V of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and that anyone who wanted to organise a procession in Glasgow must notify the Council at least 28 days prior to the date on which the procession was intended to take place;
- (2) that the Act set out the relevant considerations that the Council must take into account when considering a procession notification received from a procession organiser and in determining whether it was necessary to prohibit or impose conditions on a procession, as detailed in the report; and
- (3) of the number of procession notifications submitted to the Council in the last 4 years in respect of processions that had taken place in the city and within the relevant Council wards, between 1st April 2025 and 31st March 2026;
